The Concert Band is conducted by Steve Boulka and is an instrumental music ensemble devoted to studying and performing a variety of band literature: orchestral transcriptions, basic band repertoire, multi-movement works and contemporary compositions. Membership is based on a rigorous and comprehensive audition held at the end of each school year. The OSH Concert Band members have the responsibility of coming to rehearsals with their individual part prepared to the best of their abilities, rehearsal time is then spent on exploring music form, expression and ensemble performance. Band Department Handbook

Your student received a copy of the Band Department Handbook on the 1st day of school. Please take time to read through it with your student. It is filled with important information regarding required concert dates, grading policies and extra-curricular opportunities. The handbook signature page must be signed by you and your student. It is part of your student's first trimester grade, so make sure to turn it in on time!

Your daily homework in band is to PRACTICE

At OSH, we do not require students to complete "practice calendars" indicating how much time they practice on their instrument. However, we highly encourage daily practice! A student will improve their musical abilities significantly more by practicing a little each day instead of practicing for a longer period of time once or twice a week. Much of practicing involves the building up of muscle memory and if we leave that training for even a few days the muscles will "forget" what they learned. As a result, music practice cannot be "crammed" like a person might do for a test. Success in music can only be achieved through the repetitions that a daily practice routine brings!! Regular consistent practice is the "homework" for Band and insures musical growth, successful tests and a good grade in Band!

The general rule is to average 30 minutes of practice per day, practicing lesson material and mastering the band music. Advanced students will practice more. Some students practice less. The idea is to establish the relationship between practicing and success in band. If you practice more you will earn good grades on tests, play better and enjoy it more! This will also enhance your success in auditions.

THE MINIMAL EXPECTATION FOR PRACTICE FOR ALL OSH BAND MEMBERS IS FOUR 30 MINUTE PRACTICE SESSIONS PER WEEK

Because the internet is needed for Smart Music, students without at home internet (or dial-up), will be allowed to use music department computers and subscriptions to complete their assignments before school, after school and during guided study time. If you student is struggling to get their smartmusic assignments done due to computer availability, please speak with Mr. Boulka for assistance. Please note: You are NOT required to purchase your own home subscription. Doing so simply allows you to work from the privacy of your home. Music department computers are available (for Smart Music) before school, after school and during guided study.
